After nearly fifty years of growth, the firm updates its visual and corporate identity, rebranding simply as Lowndes.

Next-Generation Leadership

Quino Martinez assumes the role of CEO, President, and Managing Partner, marking only the fourth leadership transition in the firm's history as Bill Dymond moves to Chairman.
