



OSHA ETS – Vaccine/Testing Mandate for Large Employers: Is Your Company Ready?

On November 5, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) published its highly anticipated emergency temporary standard (ETS), which requires businesses with at least 100 employees to ensure their employees get vaccinated against COVID-19 or wear a mask and get tested on a weekly basis at minimum.
