Land use attorney **Logan Opsahl** was quoted in an August 26 *GrowthSpotter* article covering the Leesburg City Commission's initial approval of ordinances for the Oak Ridge development, a major residential project by Dix Developments.

Opsahl represented Dix Developments during the public commission meeting, where he addressed environmental concerns related to the site's prior use for cattle operations and sod stripping. His remarks during the meeting were cited in the article, highlighting the project's approach to runoff management and wetland enhancement.

The Oak Ridge Community Development District spans 752 acres and will ultimately include up to 1,466 homes across three integrated neighborhoods. The final vote on the project is scheduled for October 13.
